### SMITH IN GLASGOW 09 CALL FOR PAPERS

To mark the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the publication of the *Theory of Moral Sentiments*, the University of Glasgow, where Smith was both student and professor, will host a prestigious Conference under the auspices of the University and the Faculty of Law Business and Social Sciences' Adam Smith Research Foundation [[www.gla.ac.uk/asrf](http://www.gla.ac.uk/asrf)].

The Conference will be held between March 31<sup>st</sup> and April 2<sup>nd</sup> 2009. Recognising the breadth of Smith's interests and range of his work at Glasgow, the Conference will be organised along four themes: Smith, Scotland and the Enlightenment; Smith and Culture, Literature and the Arts; Smith and Philosophy and Smith and the Social Sciences. Each theme will have a plenary lecture and a series of up to four workshops/seminars. See the draft programme below.
